Your child will bring the following supplies with them each week. Please prepare your student's supplies in a bag (gallon size Ziploc or any school supply box/bag), *with ALL items labeled*. Students are encouraged to check their backpacks weekly to check their supplies and make sure they are ready for class on Mondays to help teach responsibility and preparation for class.
