

3rd Grade Supply List and Directions

Parents,

It is time consuming (and sometimes embarrassing) to have to use your neighbor's supplies because your backpack isn't prepared. I keep some community supplies, but sometimes, that's not enough. If your child uses their backpack for activities other than Shepherd's Heart, please keep these supplies in a 1-2-gallon ziploc bag labelled for SH so your child doesn't lose items.

1. Crayons
2. Scissors

6. Markers
7. 1-2 Glue sticks
8. A SEALABLE water bottle
9. 3-ring binder with POCKETED dividers

Divider labels should read ART, RECIPES, READING, MATH, MISC.

Please have these ready on the first day of school so we don't use precious class time on binder organization.
